BBBS NEWS & UPDATES

Big Brothers Big Sisters of Acadiana is still advising matches to meet virtually through Phase 2. However, effective today in-person visits may resume only if the parent or guardian of your Little consents to resuming match activities.

Review Guidelines that must be followed in order to resume in-person match activities.

GUIDELINES:

- Both the Big and the Little must have not had any symptoms of any illness in the last 14 days and not have had any contact with any person with any symptoms of any illness in the last 14 days prior to ANY match activity.
- In- Person visits should be limited to one visit every two weeks to allow sufficient monitoring between visits.
- In- Person visits should be limited to no more than 90 minutes, including travel time when the Big and Little are together.
- All match activities must be limited to outdoor spaces or large indoor spaces still honoring and enforcing occupancy limits and social distancing.
- Big and Littles should observe all social distancing guidelines during visits.
- Face coverings are required to be worn throughout the activity. We encourage the parent to transport the Little to and from the activity to meet their Big.
- Bigs are responsible for ensuring their vehicle is properly sanitized before transporting their Little.
- Proper hand washing and personal sanitation should be observed by both the Big and Little throughout the visit.


