


LOCAL PALOOZA - MAY 28TH - MAY 29TH

Curfew Ordinance for the City of Lafayette

The curfew ordinance is 62–89 in the municipal codes of Lafayette, La. Curfew for any person under 17 years of age, not emancipated under Louisiana Law is:

11:00 p.m. on any Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday until 6:00 a.m. of the following day; and 11:59 p.m. on any Friday or Saturday until 6:00 a.m. of the following day, if:

- A minor commits an offense if he remains in any public place or on the premises of any establishment during curfew hours.
 - (2) A custodian of a minor commits an offense if he knowingly permits or by insufficient control allows a minor to remain in any public place or on the premises of any establishment during curfew hours.

Curfew checks will be conducted throughout the summer.
